CCNC 2013 Organization Committee invites active members of community to submit workshop proposals. The workshops should be clearly focused on current or emerging topics of interest. They should allow members of the research community and industry development community to compare and discuss approaches and concepts on research topics pertinent to consumer electroncis.

CCNC workshops will be organized on the first and last day of the conference (Jan 11 and Jan 14).

Workshop proposals should include:

- * Title, goals and topics that will be addressed;
- * Relevance and significance of this workshop
- * Workshop history (if it is not the first version);
- * Estimated paper submission volume and paper acceptance rate;
- * Full day or half day workshop program;
- * If there is journal special issue arrangement of the published workshop paper;
- * A draft workshop call for papers with:
- o The names, affiliations, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses of the workshop organizers, who should be experts in the related topics and preferably from multiple institutions;
 - o The paper selection process;
 - o A list of potential Program Committee members and their affiliations.

Workshop proposals should not exceed 3 pages and should be submitted to the Workshop chairs [...].
